Third Order of Business

RESOLUTION NO. 2025-12

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE TWO RIVERS WEST COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT ADOPTING A NO FISHING POLICY; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS AND SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Two Rivers West Community Development District (the "**District**") is a local unit of special-purpose government created and existing pursuant to Chapter 190, Florida Statutes, being situated in Pasco County, Florida;

WHEREAS, the District owns and maintains various common areas including, but not limited to, stormwater ponds, lakes, ponds, wetlands, upland buffer areas, and mitigation and conservation areas within the District (the "**District-Owned Property**");

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the District (the "**Board**") is authorized to establish policies for the maintenance of stormwater ponds, natural areas, and conservation areas within the District;

WHEREAS, the District-Owned Property was not designed for fishing or other recreational activities; and

WHEREAS, in an effort to reduce damage to the District-Owner Property and to reduce harm to residents and guests, the District desires to adopt a policy governing the activities on these areas.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE TWO RIVERS WEST COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT:

- 1. <u>Incorporation of Recitals</u>. The above recitals are true and correct and by this reference are incorporated as a material part of this resolution.
- 2. <u>Adoption of No Fishing Policy</u>. The Board hereby adopts the No Fishing Policy attached hereto as **Exhibit "A"**.
- **3.** Conflicts. This Resolution replaces any prior resolutions, policies, rules, actions or any portion or content included therein in conflict with this resolution.
- **4.** <u>Severability</u>. If any section or part of a section of this resolution is declared invalid, unconstitutional, or inconsistent with any law or regulation, the validity, force and effect of any other section or part of a section of this resolution shall not thereby be affected or impaired unless it clearly appears that such part of this resolution is wholly or necessarily dependent upon the section or part of a section so held to be invalid or unconstitutional.
- 5. <u>Effective Date.</u> This Resolution shall become effective upon its passage and shall remain in effect unless rescinded, repealed, replaced, or superseded.

Two Rivers West Community Development District

Introduction

The Two Rivers West Community Development District (the "**District**") owns and maintains various common areas including, but not limited to, stormwater ponds and stormwater drainage areas within the District.

These areas provide many benefits to the District including wildlife habitat areas, natural aesthetic views, wetland recharge areas, and stormwater drainage areas. The District maintains these areas in accordance with all applicable environmental laws and regulatory permits (in some cases these areas are not intended to be maintained and are left in their natural state). Residents are prohibited from disturbing or altering the trees and vegetation in these areas without written permission from the District.

Violators of this policy are deemed to be trespassing on District property and the trespassers will be reported to the local authorities.

Please be advised that SWFWMD may levy fines for violations of their rules and regulations, up to \$10,000 per offense per day, pursuant to Section 373.430, Florida Statutes.

No Fishing Policy

- 1. No fishing or swimming is permitted in any District stormwater ponds.
- 2. No other use (including any recreational or simply walking on pond banks) of the ponds is authorized.
- 3. The stormwater ponds within the District are not natural lakes and were constructed for storm water management purposes.
- 4. The ponds are not maintained to state code for consumption of the fish found in the ponds.
- 5. Some of the fish found in the ponds assist in keeping mosquito and midge fly populations under control and assist in maintaining the water quality by mixing the water table.
- 6. This policy is adopted to support public health, safety, and welfare, by encouraging the avoidance of natural or animal hazards, and potentially avoid exacerbation of any erosion issues (which are usually very costly) due to vehicles, people, or animals standing on pond banks.
- 7. Violators are deemed to be trespassing on District property and the trespassers will be reported to the local authorities.



finances have been difficult. Budgets for school breakfast and lunch programs that don't tap into general funds and are largely dependent on federal funds.

Dustin Walker, director of food and nutrition for Pinellas County Schools, told school board members costs have skyrocketed since 2020 and haven't come back down. They initially received about \$4 million in supply chain assistance funds, he said, but that expired in 2023.

The Consumer Price Index, a tool used to measure how prices change over time, shows a 7% increase in costs, he said. The impacts of President Donald Trump's tariffs on foreign goods and potential federal reimbursement rates remain unclear.

Stephanie Spicknall, Pasco's director of food and nutrition services, said the district's meal program lost about \$4.8 million last year. This year they're projected to lose another \$5 million. The cost to produce one meal is \$3.63, she said. They are reimbursed 53 cents per meal through the U.S. Department of Agriculture.

"Our cost of food and supplies

are at an all-time high and rising," she said. "We now are facing tariffs. So that's just lots of funding uncertainty and fiscal uncertainty in our program right now.

"Our main federal reimbursement is the (U.S. Department of Agriculture) reimbursement rate that is issued annually in July," she added. "So we don't even know what our main source of funding will be for next school year."

Both Pinellas and Pasco counties said they are exploring other ways to lower costs and offer different options.

Walker said Pinellas schools would be piloting a "scratch kitchen" program to offer more restaurant style or skillet cooking as opposed to "heat and eat." They would explore different distributors, he said.

Still, Spicknall said, federal regulations make it difficult to go too outside the box.

"We have very strict nutrition parameters," she said. "They've already reduced salt down to a therapeutic diet, and they're going to target sugar next, but we try our best and work with manufacturers to create palatable items that students do still love to consume.

"So, yeah, I can't just go find a better price for macaroni and cheese or the pancakes, because they have to be whole-grain rich and meet certain parameters for sodium and fat and all other criteria."

When asked by Pasco's school board if the Trump administration had loosened any of those dietary requirements, Spicknall said that if anything, they had gotten more strict, with anticipated bans on food dyes coming

Spicknall said there is also legislation to change what schools qualify for free meals. Additionally, federal aid cuts could shrink the number of students eligible for free meals.

Walker said Pinellas County will be encouraging more eligible families to apply for free or reduced lunch.

"We've also had conversations about how we make sure that our cafeteria managers are ready if they're seeing the trend of a student who can't or isn't coming (for meals)," he said. "We're making sure that we follow back up as a food nutrition department, not always just the principal or (assistant principal) having those kind of conversations."







The city of Sarasota forwarded a request from the community for approval of an eye-catching aqua blue color scheme as the default color on the Ringling Bridge when it isn't lit up in red, white and blue for the holidays observed by the state. That was approved, and those colors lit up earlier this month.

But they can't overrule the new policy on their own.

'The city of Sarasota does not have jurisdiction over the Ringling Bridge lighting. As such, the City Commission is not able to accept or consider individual lighting requests," a city statement said.

From 2020 to 2023, the Skyway Bridge had a vibrant rainbow light display for one week in June to honor Pride Month. But a single Manatee County commissioner who expressed disapproval of requests for light displays honoring Pride and Gun Violence Awareness

nixed the plans in 2024.

County Commissioner Mike Rahn said at the time that the requests from various groups "has somewhat gotten out of control," and added: "It should not fall with us as a county commission; it should fall on FDOT."

St. Pete Pride president Byron Green-Calisch said he was disappointed but not surprised.

"The state of Florida is amazing in the plethora of ways it is looking to be noninclusive when we should be welcoming more people to enrich our economy."

He said some people may not realize what a lift to the spirits something like the Skyway Bridge lit up in a rainbow of lights is.

"It is a reminder that you are not alone," he said.

On the upside, Green-Calisch said he hasn't been turned down by any businesses, buildings or organizations in St. Petersburg to put Pride flags out front or in their windows in the coming weeks. He braced himself after news broke that Moffitt Cancer Center in Tampa decided not to





A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE TWO RIVERS WEST COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT ALLOCATING \$3,371,710 FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A PORTION OF COLSTON SECTION 4/5 WITH THE BOND PROCEEDS FROM THE \$18,285,000 TWO RIVERS WEST COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT SPECIAL ASSESSMENT BONDS, SERIES 2024 (SERIES 2024 PROJECT) AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Two Rivers West Community Development District (the "**District**") intends to construct the portion of Colston Section 4/5 serving Two Rivers Community Development District; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the District (the "**Board**") issued the \$18,285,000 Two Rivers West Community Development District Special Assessment Bonds, Series 2024 (Series 2024 Project) (the "**Series 2024 Bonds**") to fund the construction of Colston Section 4/5; and

WHEREAS, the Board desires to allocate \$3,802,941 from the Series 2024 Bonds for the construction of Colston Section 4/5.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> <u>Authority for This Resolution</u>. This Resolution is adopted pursuant to Chapter 190, Florida Statutes.

Section 2. Allocation for Colston Section 4/5. The District hereby allocates 3,802,941 from the Series 2024 Bonds Construction Account for the construction of Colston Section 4/5. Prior to approving any requisitions, the District Manager and District Engineer shall verify with the Trustee of the Series 2024 Bonds that there are sufficient funds remaining to cover the costs necessary to construct Colston Section 4/5.

ITEM 1-2RIVERS BLVD

Due By: Monday, July 14, 2025

Assigned To: Down To Earth.

Photos 1 and 2:

These photos show the monument located at the intersection of State Road 56 and Two Rivers Boulevard. The monument itself is in good condition, and the landscaping in front of it is well-maintained. There are a few weeds present in the bed, but it looks like they have already been treated.

Photos 3 and 4:

These photos show the center island just inside the entrance to the community off Two Rivers Boulevard. This area has a significant amount of weeds growing both between the plants and throughout the bed. It requires immediate attention and should be treated with weed control to improve its appearance and prevent further overgrowth.









ITEM 2-2RIVERS BLVD.

Due By: Monday, July 14, 2025 Assigned To: DOWN TO EARTH.

Photo 1:

The flowers at the main entrance of Two Rivers off 2 Rivers Blvd are in excellent condition. They are vibrant, healthy, and add great visual appeal to the entryway.

Photos 2, 3, and 4:

The center island along Two Rivers Boulevard, approaching Big Hawk Dr, has a noticeable amount of weeds throughout the area. These need to be addressed promptly and treated with appropriate weed control measures to maintain the community's appearance.









ITEM 3-BIG HAWK DR.

Due By: Monday, July 14, 2025 Assigned To: DOWN TO EARTH.

Photos 1 and 2:

Off Two Rivers Boulevard, just past Big Hawk Drive heading toward Colston, the turf is in good condition.

Photos 3 and 4:

Off Two Rivers Boulevard, just past Big Hawk Drive heading toward Colston, the center island and pocket parks have weeds growing between plants and throughout the beds. The Blue Daze is also being overtaken by larger weeds. These areas need immediate attention and weed control.









ITEM 4- WISE RIVER LN.

Tamara Rack - Wise River Lane Entrance

Photo 1: Confederate Jasmine is overgrown onto the wall and curb. Needs trimming for better appearance.

Tamara Rack - Main Entrance

Photo 2: Weeds are growing in the bed and around the azalea at the center island. Needs weed control.

Tamara Rack – Just Past Entrance Monuments Photo 3: Remove the dead from the Crinum lily, and weeds are present in the Liriope. Needs attention for improved appearance.







ITEM 5- WISE RIVER LN.

Tamara Rack - Landscape Bed Along Community Wall

Photos 1 and 2: The landscape bed running from Wise River Lane along the left side of the community wall out to Two Rivers Boulevard is overrun with grass and weeds. It needs immediate attention and weed control treatment.

Tamara Rack – Pond Area

Photos 1 and 2: The pond was recently treated for primrose weeds, and torpedo grass, which are now dying off as a result of the treatment.





ITEM 7- WISE RIVER LN.

Assigned To: DOWN TO EARTH.

Turf Condition -

Photo 1 (Current) vs. Photo 2 (Last Month): Turf has shown a significant improvement since last month's inspection. Photo 1 from today highlights healthier, greener turf compared to Photo 2 taken during the previous inspection.





ITEM 8- WISE RIVER LN.

Due By: Monday, July 21, 2025 Assigned To: DOWN TO EARTH.

Tree & Bed Maintenance

Photos 1 and 2: Crepe myrtles still have tree sprouts at the base that were previously requested to be removed but have not yet been addressed. In Photo 2, there are also weeds visible in the Liriope that need to be removed.

Palm Maintenance

Photos 3 and 4: The Coontie palms need dead material removed, and approximately six palms need to be replaced.









ITEM 9- WISE RIVER LN.

Due By: Monday, July 21, 2025 Assigned To: DOWN TO EARTH.

Overspray Awareness

Photo 1: The photo shows that while crack weeds along the sidewalk were sprayed, some overspray reached the turf. The crew should take extra care when spraying near the grass to avoid turf damage.

Photo 2: Weeds are growing between the plants in front of the mailboxes and should be removed.

Photo 3: A large weed is growing between the ornamental grasses and needs to be removed.

Photo 4: The Coontie palm needs dead material removed, and four palms require replacement.









ITEM 10- WISE RIVER LN & COLSTON AVE

Assigned To: LANDSCAPE MAINTENANCE PROFESSIONAL. & JUNIPER LANDSCAPING.

Turf Replacement Needed – Tamara Rack Entrance

Photos 1 and 2: Turf is dead and needs to be replaced on both sides of the entrance at Wise River Lane and Colston Avenue.

Weed Control - Tamara Rack Entrance

Photos 3 and 4: A significant amount of weeds is growing on both sides of the entrance. These areas should be addressed as soon as possible and treated with weed control where needed.









ITEM 11- WISE RIVER LN & COLSTON AVE.

Assigned To: LANDSCAPE MAINTENANCE PROFESSIONAL & JUNIPER LANDSCAPING

Jasmine Beds – Maintenance & Replacement

Photos 1, 2, and 3: There is a significant amount of weeds in the jasmine beds that need to be addressed as soon as possible. Additionally, some areas require new jasmine to be installed.







ITEM 12- DRUMMOND PT. & COLSTON AVE.

Due By: Monday, July 21, 2025

Assigned To: LANDSCAPE MAINTENANCE PROFESSIONALS & JUNIPER LANDSCAPING.

New Planting Bed - Colston Ave & Drummond PT.

Photo 1: Recently installed jasmine and juniper look good, but the bed has a significant amount of weeds that need to be removed before mulch can be applied.

Jasmine Bed Maintenance

Photos 2 and 3: There is a significant amount of weeds growing in the jasmine bed. Photo 2 also shows areas where jasmine is missing and needs to be added to complete the bed.

Weed Control - Near MI Homes Model Center

Photo 4: The bed next to the MI Homes Model Center, heading toward Morris Bridge Road, is full of weeds and needs to be taken care of as soon as possible.









ITEM 13- COLSTON AVE & MORRIS BRIDGE RD.

Due By: Monday, July 28, 2025

Assigned To: LANDSCAPE MAINTENANCE PROFESSIONALS & JUNIPER LANDSCAPING.

Plant Replacement – Entrance at Colston Ave & Morris Bridge Road Photos 1 and 2: Three dead azaleas are visible at the entrance and need to be replaced.

Photos 3 and 4: A significant amount of weeds is growing in the jasmine beds at the entrance of Two Rivers West off Morris Bridge Road and Colston Avenue. These areas need to be addressed as soon as possible.









ITEM 14- COLSTON AVE.

Due By: Monday, July 28, 2025

Assigned To: JUNIPER LANDSCAPING.

Photos 1, 2, and 3: Several dead trees are visible along Colston Avenue heading toward Two Rivers Boulevard. Juniper is aware and is working on a plan to have them replaced as soon as possible.







ITEM 15- EMBERVIEW DR.

Due By: Monday, July 21, 2025 Assigned To: DOWN TO EARTH.

Liriope Damage

Photo 1: Weeds in the bed were taken care of, but some Liriope was also damaged—likely by a weed eater. A few plants need to be replaced and installed as soon as possible.

Turf & Sidewalk Condition


Photo 2: The turf appears green, healthy, and well-maintained. The sidewalk is neatly edged and free of weeds, showing good overall maintenance.

Plant Replacement – Mailbox Area by Pond Photo 3: To the left of the mailboxes, next to the pond, there are three dead Simpson's stoppers that need to be replaced.

Mailbox Area – General Condition

Photo 4: While there are a few minor details to address—such as plant replacements, trimming, and some weeds—the overall landscape near the mailboxes looks well-maintained. The pond area is clean, and the beds are in good condition.









ITEM 16- EMBERVIEW DR.

Due By: Monday, July 28, 2025 Assigned To: DOWN TO EARTH.

Weed Control - Lift Station Area

Photos 1, 2, and 3: There is a significant amount of weeds throughout the beds next to the lift station that need to be addressed as soon as possible and treated with weed control where needed. The crew should also be careful when spraying around plants—as seen in Photo 1, there is some overspray on the Liriope that caused damage.







ITEM 17- STABLETON LN.

Due By: Monday, July 28, 2025 Assigned To: DOWN TO EARTH.

Weed Control - Stableton Ln. Cul-de-Sac

Photos 1, 2, and 3: Although some weeds were sprayed, the landscape beds at the end of Stableton Lane (cul-de-sac) still have a significant amount of weeds growing between the plants and throughout the bed. Further treatment is needed.

Tree Support Needed

Photo 4: A tree is still laying on the grass and has not yet been straightened or securely strapped down. This was noted in the previous report and remains incomplete.









ITEM 18- STABLETON LN.

Due By: Monday, July 28, 2025 Assigned To: DOWN TO EARTH.

Landscape Bed – Stableton Lane Cul-de-Sac

Photo1- The bed located between Colston Avenue and Stableton Lane has a significant amount of weeds. In addition, the ornamental grasses need to be separated from the Viburnum hedge to improve definition and appearance.

Tree Support Needed - Ornamental Grass Area

Photo 2: A tree is still laying on top of the ornamental grasses and has not been straightened or secured. This item was noted in the previous report and remains incomplete.

Tree & Bed Maintenance – Colston Ave to Stableton (toward Webstone Way)
Photo 3: There are two dead pine trees in the landscape bed between Colston Avenue and
Stableton, heading toward Webstone Way, that need to be removed and replaced.
Additionally, the area behind the Viburnum hedge, between the hedge and the silt fence,
should be weed-eated and treated with weed control to maintain a clean appearance.







ITEM 19- BIG HAWK DR.

Assigned To: SITEX AQUATICS.

POND 3-was treated for filamentous, algae, and shoreline weeds that are now beginning to die off.
